

## **Professor Judit Oláh, MD, PhD, DSc**

Judit Oláh, MD, PhD, DSc, is university professor and head of the Department of Oncotherapy, University of Szeged (Hungary). She earned her medical degree from Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical University in Szeged in 1985, and awarded her PhD in 2003, Doctor of Science, Hungarian Academy of Sciences in 2016 in Budapest and habilitation from the University of Szeged in 2011. She also completed specialization training in dermatology (1990) and clinical oncology (1998), and conducted additional studies at Harvard Medical School (United States), the National Cancer Institute (Budapest), and the Medical Universities of Halle and Erlangen (Germany). The recipient of numerous research grants, Professor Oláh maintains clinical study interests in prognostic and predisposing factors in cutaneous melanoma patients as well as immunological and clinical investigations in patients with cutaneous and other tumors. She has 283 publications, including abstracts and book chapters, and has given numerous invited presentations on topics related to her areas of expertise. President of the Dermato-Oncological Section of the Hungarian Dermatological Society, Professor Oláh is a board member of the European Association of Dermato-Oncology, Hungarian Clinical Oncological Society and Hungarian Dermatological Society, and a member of the European Academy of Dermatology and Venerology and Hungarian Oncological Society. She is the Honorary Member of the Serbian Association of Dermatovenereologists.
