

Dr Pablo Ortiz-Romero attended the Medical School of the University Complutense, finishing in 1985. In 1990 he completed his residency for Dermatology. In 1992 he got his PhD degree and joined the Department of Dermatology of the University Hospital 12 de Octubre. In 1997 he took the responsibility of the cutaneous lymphoma and melanoma unit in his department. In 2008 he got the position of Professor of Dermatology. He has been head of the Department of Dermatology since 2017.

He has been a member of the EORTC Melanoma Group since 1997. He served as Secretary General of the EORTC Cutaneous Lymphoma Task Force for 6 years and has been a member of the EORTC CLTF and the ISCL for 4 and 6 additional years respectively.

Dr Ortiz-Romero has published more than 200 papers in indexed journals and has presented more than 300 talks/conferences in different national or international meetings.

At present he is a member of the Spanish Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (AEDV), the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (EADV), the American Academy of Dermatology (AAD), the European Dermatology Forum (EDF), the EORTC Melanoma Group, the International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas (ISCL) and the EORTC Cutaneous Lymphoma Group.
