Focus: Occupational dermatology, including the implementation of systematic interdisciplinary approaches to the prevention of occupational skin diseases with an emphasis on workers' education strategies ("Osnabrueck model"). SMJ wrote >300 papers (*h*-index 44) and is lead-editor of major textbooks in the field, e.g. *Kanerva's Occupational Dermatology*. He coordinates the Pan-European awareness raising EADV "Healthy Skin@Work campaign (Slogan: "Your skin. The most important 2m<sup>2</sup> of your life"). He is also member of the ILO "Core Experts Group on the Guidance Notes on Diagnostic and Exposure Criteria for the Occupational Diseases List" and the WHO "InterSun project advisory committee" as well as the lead reviewer to the recent ILO/WHO global burden of occupational diseases project ("Joint methodology", WG 4: Skin Cancer by UV).
