Dr. Bataille graduated from the Louvain Medical School in Brussels in July 1985 with Magnum Cum Laude. She started her dermatology training at St John's Institute of Dermatology Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust London in 1989. She then moved to Imperial Cancer Research Fund in London and The Royal London Hospital as a Clinical Research Fellow where she completed her PhD. on the genetic epidemiology of skin and eye melanoma in 1995.

Dr. Bataille became a Consultant Dermatologist in 1996, when she was appointed Senior Lecturer and Honorary Consultant Dermatologist at Barts and The London School of Medicine in London. Since 2004, Dr Bataille has run melanoma services at West Hertfordshire Hospitals NHS Trust and Mount Vernon Cancer Centre. She also works at the Twin Research and Genetic Epidemiology Department at Kings College, London on the genetics of melanoma and other skin diseases. She is member of the British Association of Dermatologists and the Royal College of Physicians. She has published in numerous peer-review journals and regularly writes reviews and book chapters on skin cancer and other aspects of dermatology. She is a Board Member of the EADO and the EORTC melanoma group. She is currently Assistant Editor of the Acta Dermatologica Venereologica.
