

**Marit B. Veierød** is Professor and Group Leader at the Oslo Centre for Biostatistics and Epidemiology, and Deputy Chair at the Department of Biostatistics, Institute of Basic Medical Sciences, Faculty of Medicine, University of Oslo. She holds a PhD in biostatistics and epidemiology. Prof. Veierød and her group are studying the associations between pigmentation factors, UV exposure, physical activity and other lifestyle factors and risk of melanoma and squamous cell carcinoma, and recently also associations between these host- and lifestyle factors and survival after melanoma diagnosis. She has published 200 peer-reviewed papers, and is a member of the Norwegian Academy of Science and Letters.
