

Dr. Noemi Eiris Salvado is a Dermatology Consultant at the Hospital Universitario Virgen Macarena, in Seville, Spain. Currently she is part of the Dermato-oncology team in charge of medical and surgical management of non-melanoma skin cancers and also the Psoriasis unit.

She graduated in Medicine from the University of Oviedo, and then completed her Dermatology Residency at the Hospital Universitario Central de Asturias, in Northern Spain. There, she developed an interest in Psoriasis, which led to a collaboration with a group of like-minded clinicians and researchers at the University of Oviedo in multiple studies in that area and to the completion of a PhD regarding genetic variations in psoriatic patients in 2017.

After completing her Dermatology training, she went on to work for several years at the Dermatology Department of the Complejo Universitario Asistencial de León, a decidedly dermato-oncological and surgical oriented-center in the North-West of Spain, where she continued her training in surgical techniques such as Mohs Micrographic surgery.

Dr. Eiris is a member of the Academia Española de Dermatología y Venereología, Grupo Español de Dermatooncología y Cirugía, published several articles in the dermato-oncology and surgical dermatology area and recently co-authored a book on perioperative Dermatological Surgery.
